Annual Performance Report for Imagine Leadership Academy

SY 2022-2023 DATA

The North Central Ohio Educational Service Center (NCOESC) community school sponsorship seeks to develop positive relationships and support school leaders/developers who provide high-quality educational experiences for students throughout the state of Ohio. Every year, the NCOESC provides an Annual Performance Report for each of its sponsored community schools. The following report provides an overview of the school and a summary of its performance in academics, fiscal, organizational/operational, and adherence to legal compliance over the most recent school year and the term of the sponsorship contract.

NCOESC provides rigorous oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance to our sponsored schools with processes and protocols that align with standards developed by the National Association of Charter School Authorizers and the state of Ohio's Sponsor Performance Review. NCOESC collects data from its sponsored schools throughout the year to determine specifically the extent to which each school is performing in the following four areas: academic, fiscal, operational/organizational and legal compliance. Data gathered through a variety of means reviewed and analyzed to determine school's performance includes the following:

- Site visits to schools, including walkthroughs while school is in session with findings reported to the governing authority at meetings;
- Monthly financial reviews;
- Attendance at community school governing authority board meetings;
- Ongoing reviews of assessment data highlighting student achievement and growth;
- Ongoing reviews in the areas of state and federal compliance, academics, special education, operations, and finance;
- Ongoing technical assistance delivered by trained and experienced staff; and,
- Reviews of reports electronically submitted to the NCOESC compliance-tracking database.

ACADEMIC SUMMARY

(Did not Meet Expectations)

Imagine Leadership Academy (ILA) continues to work diligently in support of helping students reach academic goals. The achievement component grade on the Ohio Report card represents whether student performance on state tests met established thresholds and how well students performed on state tests overall. ILA has rebounded on their Performance Index Component to pre-pandemic performance in 2019. This is significant gains and students; teachers and administrators should be commended for these academic gains. The academy also did well in gap closing and progress! As your sponsor, we encourage you to continue and congratulate you on your success.

Areas for improvement are the early literacy, attendance and chronic absenteeism. These areas should be a part of the school's improvement plans.

ILA has been identified as a comprehensive support and improvement school. They continue to work collaboratively with SST6 for their school-wide academic improvement initiatives.
